

PROCEDURES: This event is open to everyone. Volkssports are noncompetitive events. Each participant, whether free or paid, must register and sign an Amateur Athletic Waiver and Release of Liability (Parent or Guardian must sign for a minor) at the start point. A control (start) card will be issued upon registration that must be carried during the walk, validated at control points along the route, and turned in at the finish upon completion of the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

DISCLAIMER: The sponsors are not liable for accidents, thefts, and/or material damage. Every reasonable effort will be made by the sponsors to make this a safe, enjoyable, and memorable event. A waiver must be signed by those participating in any event. A parent or guardian must sign for children under 18.

START LOCATION: American River Canyon Overlook Park, 855 Pacific Ave., Auburn 95603

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The walks are on paved roads and a stretch that is on a fine gravel roadway. Both walks include a dip into the canyon high above the Middle Fork of the American River. The 5k includes an alternate route along the bank of a Gold Rush era water ditch. This alternate route is rated 2C and is not suitable for either wheelchairs or strollers.

AWARD: none

REGISTRATION FEES: All walkers \$4.00. Donations appreciated.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Walking the USA, A-Z (letter A), Par for the Course, Placer County, & Walking with Woody.

MISCELLANEOUS: Water and restrooms at the Start/Finish with a Port-A-Pottie on the trail. Pets are permitted on a leash with cleanup. Both walks are suitable for strollers, but not wheelchairs. This walk event will take place regardless of the weather conditions.

STIPULATIONS: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA) a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports and counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. With registration for this event, the participant accepts the guidelines of the AVA and agrees to observe the principles of good sportsmanship and safety. This walk event will take place regardless of the weather conditions.
