

CALIFORNIA VOLKSSPORT ASSOCIATION ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES May 6, 2023

1. CVA Annual Meeting Official Opening

• The 2023 California Volkssport Association (CVA) annual membership meeting was opened 1:09pm by Cathy Pauley, CVA President. Diane Stauffer lead the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

2. Introductions

 Cathy Pauley recognized and introduced members of the CVA State Executive Council (SEC): VP North Heidi Foster, VP Central Priscilla Fife, VP South Maureen Carlson, Treasurer Steve Hughart and Secretary Diane Gomes.

3. Report of Quorum

• Diane Gomes, CVA Secretary reported that we have a quorum. One hundred percent (100%) of voting members were present (60% required for quorum)

4. Introduction of Carl Cordes, AVA Pacific Regional Director

• Cathy Pauley introduced Carl Cordes, AVA Pacific Regional Director

5. AVA Pacific Regional Director, Report

- Carl asked, "Is this the last generation of AVA?"
- Succession is a serious problem that needs to be addressed. How to bring in new members and how to encourage members to step up.
- Both Carl and Suzi's positions as PARD and PADRD are over in July 2023, but as of today no one has stepped up as a possible replacement for either position. Two Term limit.
- Carl discussed some of the PARD job requirements. The PARD covers CA, HI, NV and AZ. There is some travel with some reimbursement available. The RD is required to be on other committees within AVA. For example, he is on the Awards and Certificates committee. RDs and DRDs have a window into AVA which is an opportunity to make changes you are passionate about.
- The busiest time for an RD is Year End Event (YRE) renewals.
- Carl asked that we think about Succession at the club and region level. It is the only way
 for AVA to continue.
- Club Anniversaries. Carl presented and recognized clubs celebrating milestone anniversaries this year. They included Central Coast Beach Boardwalkers (5 years), CVA (40 years), Low Desert Roadrunners (40).
- Individual awards were given to Delta Tule Trekkers members (Jeanette Farley, Brandi Morick, Marcelo Fernandez, Jim Gomes, Diane Gomes, Charlene Henshaw and Wanda

Martin) and Las Vegas Strollers member Brenda Harris for her Meritorious Service as club treasurer for 15 years.

6. IX Olympiad Report

- CA clubs were well represented. There were 1,021 Participants, 23 Countries and 42
 States.
- The next Olympiad will be in 2025 in Finland. The brochure will be put on the CVA website for anyone who is interested.

7. Approval of Minutes from May 14, 2022

 The 2022 CVA Annual Meeting minutes were emailed to each club on April 19, 2023, for their review. Diane made the motion to accept the minutes and Heidi Foster seconded the motion. The minutes were approved with 25 votes.

 options.
